the FireHose project

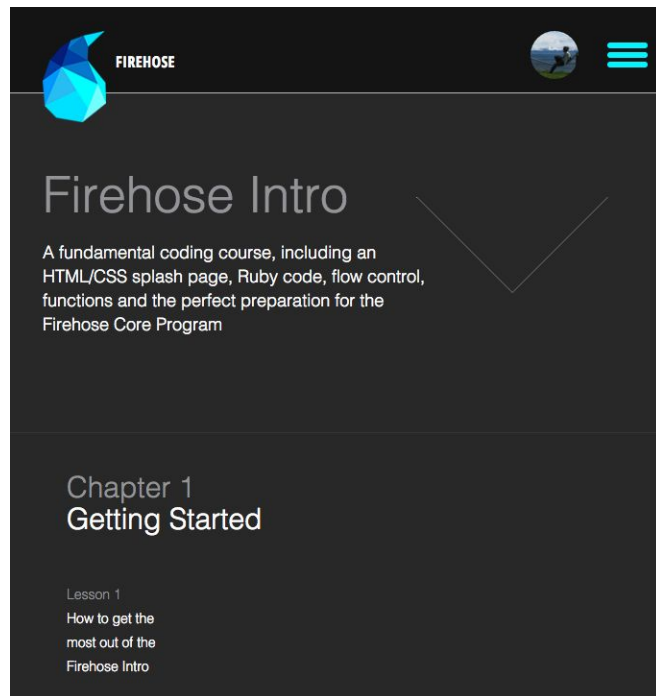
15 week world-class coding bootcamp,
